
PROTECTION FROM ONLINE FALSEHOODS AND MANIPULATION BILL

Four Key Things About the Bill



Damage to society by malicious actors who spread online falsehoods

How does the Bill define "falsehood" ?

A statement of **fact** that is false or misleading

Opinions, criticism, satire and parody are not covered



What does the Bill do?

- In most cases, put up correction alongside falsehood
- In some cases, take down falsehoods that can cause serious harm
- Disable fake accounts that amplify falsehoods
- Cut off profits of sites that repeatedly spread falsehoods
- Impose criminal sanctions on malicious actors
- Set out binding Codes of Practice for technology companies



What are the Bill's safeguards?

- Bill deals with falsehoods that harm the public interest
- Right of appeal to the Courts, who have final say over falsity
